

LIST OF SUGGESTIONS FOR YOU TO FOLLOW WITH YOUR NEW PUPPY

Please read over and initial at the bottom

Feed and house the dog properly {indoors}.

Maintain a yearly exam and vaccinate according to your veterinarian's recommendations.

Control the dog on a harness or leash when in public and when off the premises of the dog's home.

The dog's outdoor area should be fenced in and secure or acceptable provisions should be made to assure the dog is safe any time he/she is outdoors.

Give the dog proper physical and emotional care and welfare. Make the dog a part of your family.

Provide fresh water at all times.

Feed a good quality dog food. There are several website that rate dog food.

Make sure your dog has a collar on with dog tags in case someone needs to contact you.

Female dogs will come into heat as early as six months of age and the heat cycle will last for approximately three weeks. Never leave a female alone while in heat unattended. Male dogs will wander if there are females in the area in heat. Make sure all fencing in secure for all male dogs. The best way to prevent unwanted mishaps is to spay and neuter by six months of age.
